Clerk reported Cloughton Parish council were getting similar complaints. **Agreed** Clerk to see if process for declassifying as a highway could begin. Cllr. Tidd reported the tubs at the war memorial had been planted. Cllr. Hill asked if anything could be done about 1] the trailer for sale which had been parking in the turning circle of Limestone Grove for several months (Clerk to pass to Police) and 2] the untidy state of 8 Limestone Road. Cllr. Graves reported he had concerns as to the impact the proposed 155 houses in the Duchy's planning application at Cloughton would have on Burniston, especially the school, traffic and both surface water and sewage. Cllr. Crook reported the old allotments were being used by young children as a mini-moto and quad bike race track (Clerk to pass to Police, Cllr. Backhouse to pass to SBC)
